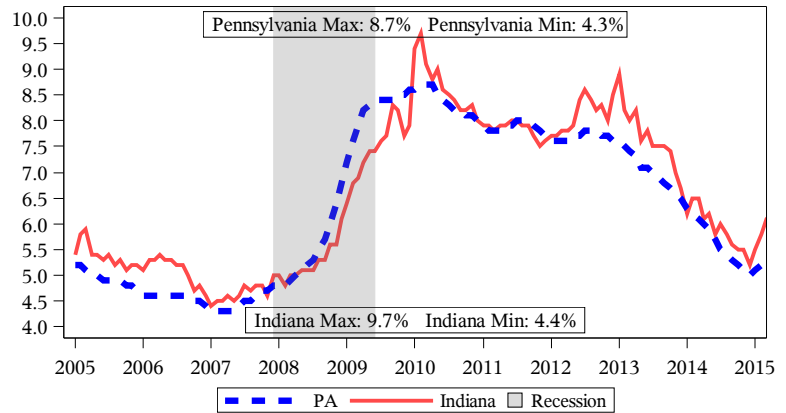


Indiana Unemployment Rate, Jan. 2005 to Dec. 2015
