FOOTNOTES

- 1) Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2) Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3) Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
- 4) Due to methodological changes and conversions to the 2020 Census-based area delineations, seasonally adjusted substate area LAUS data is not available until further notice.

NOTE: Because the data included in each month's press release (primarily civilian labor force and nonfarm jobs data) are sample based, the data are subject to revisions. Once each year, estimates are adjusted to new levels based on additional or revised information collected after the initial release of the data (called a benchmark). Seasonal adjustment factors for historical labor force and nonfarm jobs data have also been updated. Additionally, the revised data reflects new geographic area definitions based on the 2020 Census Area Delineation. Revisions to the nonfarm jobs series through 2024 have been completed and are reflected in the January news release. Revisions to the historical labor force series have not been completed and are not yet reflected in the January news release and BLS has temporarily stopped production of substate seasonally adjusted LAUS data until further notice. Historical not seasonally adjusted labor force revisions are expected to be completed by the release of March data in late April 2025. In addition to the benchmark process, the methodology and scope of Non-CES Areas estimation has changed. Non-CES Areas (counties that are not included in Metropolitan Statistical Areas) are now being published only at the total nonfarm job level.
